Position Description

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Summary:

Install, configure and troubleshoot voice/data networks and associated assemblies and coordinate wide area computers network activities. Manage and support all applications installed on servers and workstations.

Responsibilities:

1. Monitor and manage network activities, keeping system information up-to-date in a network log and all components are operating correctly.
2. Create and maintain user accounts and appropriate access to resources.
3. Implement and support network resources.
4. Configuration Management: Plan the original configuration, expand it, and maintain the configuration information and documentation.
5. Monitor and track network activity to maintain and enhance the system's performance.
6. Oversee backup and security procedures.
7. Remain abreast of changes in network system software and hardware requirements, and make recommendations on software and hardware purchases.
8. Ensure all software is licensed, registered with the appropriate vendor of manufacturer and the licenses and warranties are on file.
9. Respond to the needs and questions of network users concerning their access to network resources.
10. Coordinate telecommunication infrastructure maintenance and testing.
11. Evaluate user needs and makes recommendations for appropriate telephone and voice functioning and training.

12. Write reports, business correspondence, and procedure manuals.
13. Efficiently present information and respond to questions from groups of managers, clients, customers, and the general public.
14. Provide information and explain Players Club benefits, property amenities & marketing programs to our guests.
15. Provide courteous service to our guests and be cordial to all Team Members.
16. Communicate effectively both orally and in writing.
17. Shall be polite and maintain a priority system in accepting other position related job duties as assigned.

WORKING CONDITIONS & ENVIRONMENT

1. Work is subject to frequent and prolonged sitting, and lifting up to 60 pounds.
2. Work occasionally involves working in confined spaces.

3. Certifications in network administration and telecommunications strongly encouraged.
 - Certified Cisco Network Associate mandatory OR ability to obtain within 12 months of employment. Certified Cisco Network professional (preferred).
4. Must possess reasonable ability to communicate in English
5. Ability to read, analyze, and interpret general business periodicals, professional journals, technical procedures, or governmental regulations.
6. Apply advanced mathematical concepts such as exponents, logarithms, quadratic equations and permutations.
7. Apply mathematical operations to such tasks as frequency distribution, determination of test reliability and validity, analysis of variance, correlation techniques, sampling theory and factor analysis.
8. Ability to define problems, collect data, establish facts, and draw valid conclusions.
9. Ability to interpret and extensive variety of technical instructions in mathematical or diagram form and deal with several abstract and concrete variables.
10. Strong guest service skills.

11. Ability to independently analyze, trouble shoot and resolve problems
12. Excellent verbal and communication skills.
13. In-depth knowledge of personal computer hardware and software.
14. Strong understanding of enterprise level relational database systems.
