Higher Education Grant Eligibility Requirements



Student must be an enrolled Karuk Tribal member.

Student must be pursuing an Associate of Arts (AA), Associate of Science (AS), Bachelor of Arts (BA), or Bachelor of Science (BS) degree.

> No funding is available for Graduate Students.

Students must be enrolled full-time which is defined as 12 units or more.

Students must maintain a 2.0 Grade Point Average (GPA) every grading term.

Students must remain in good standing with the educational institution they attend.

Students are not eligible for grants from the Education Department of the Karuk Tribe if they are in default with the Tribe for any loan.

Students must reapply for education grants each school year.

➢ Grant payments are sent directly to the school only after ALL of the following paperwork is completed:

- Grant application
- Privacy Act Waiver (PAW)
- Financial Needs Analysis (FNA)
