Renovating Refrigerated Conex at Tishaniik Garden

Proposed Dates: Complete by August 30th, 2024

The Karuk Tribe requests proposals for enhancing our refrigerated Conex at Tishaniik Farm. The Conex Dimensions are as follows: the flooring will need to be cut to size as it is 4' x 8' and the inside is 7'5". Responsibilities include building an air-tight interior partition wall, and install air-tight aluminum sheeting flooring. Most of the building materials necessary for both tasks are purchased. However, there are a few items that need to be purchased. Requestors must provide own tools, and materials necessary to complete these tasks.

- **Tasks**

- Build and install an air tight wooden wall
 - Some supplies are provided (plastic paneling, foam insulated boards, and silicone) and can be inventoried at the site visit
- Install air-tight aluminum flooring and foam insulation
 - Some supplies are provided (aluminum sheeting) and can be inventoried at the site visit.

Required:

- Knowledge in construction
- Familiar with refrigerated Conex storage containers
- Mandatory site visit walk-through before and after completion of the project
 - Bids will only be accepted from individuals who attend one of the mandatory site visits.
