The Karuk Tribe TANF Program requests proposals for the following Scope of Work required for **Cultural Mentors** for the **2024 Happy Camp Culture Class** from June 26, 2024, through December 31, 2024, in Happy Camp. Areas of interest include (but are not limited to) traditional leather dress making, maple bark skirts, bear grass braiding, pine nut processing, beadwork, leatherwork, sewing.

Cultural Mentors will be responsible for the following:

- Must be at least 21 years of age.
- Will be responsible for the youth and must know their names and faces.
- May provide up to three 1-3-hour sessions per week.
- One class per week required to be at the TANF Administration building at 533 Jacobs Way during scheduled Culture Class times.
- May mentor 1-3 tribal youth in traditional dressmaking at one time.
- Mentors may be mothers, aunts, grandmothers, guardians or other relatives of tribal youth.
- Agree to the rule of three. No cultural mentor may be alone with a single child where others cannot observe the cultural mentor.
- Understand that sensitive information about a youth's abilities, relationships, or background must be kept confidential.
- Are required to have a background check completed before becoming a cultural mentor at the Tribe's expense.
