The Karuk Tribe requests proposals for the following Scope of Work required for designing and implementing a two-day training for cultural monitoring of construction projects and other ground disturbing activities. The location of the training will be Happy Camp, California. The dates will be coordinated with the Karuk Tribal Historic Preservation Office, and are tentatively scheduled for November 16th -17th.

Task One

Design curriculum and schedule to cover relevant skills and knowledge for monitoring projects with the potential to impact cultural resources. At a minimum this training should include the legal framework of cultural resource law, field methods for identification of cultural resources, documentation and record keeping, safety and communication, and role of monitoring in culture resource management.

Task Two

Conduct a comprehensive two-day training to include classroom instruction and in-the-field practicum.

Task Three

Provide binder of written training materials and administer test to determine certification of participants. (The Tribe will provide certificates for successful candidates).

Responses to this Request for Proposals should include the following:

- 1) A statement of qualifications, including relevant work history. The principal investigator must meet the Secretary of Interior Standards for a professional archaeologist, and have demonstrated knowledge and experience preparing and teaching tribal cultural monitor courses. A proposed approach and rational for completion of the contract tasks described above, including descriptions of similar work previously completed and the results/benefits achieved.
- 2) A proposed approach and rational for completion of the contract tasks described above, including descriptions of similar work previously completed and the results/benefits achieved.
- 3) A lump sum price, with attached hourly and travel expense rate sheet.
- 4) Names and telephone numbers of three client references.
