The Karuk Tribe requests proposals for the following Scope of Work required for the design of additional space for the Anaykaam Center located at 64236 Second Ave. Happy Camp, Ca 96039. A preliminary design will be available to potential bidders for review and bidding purposes. The design of this project will include the renovation and addition specifications for the existing 3,200sqft structure as well as the 2,200sqft (approx.) of proposed additional office, training and restroom space located on the West side of the existing facility. The proposed addition will require a redesign of the surrounding parking lot, to maximize available parking and handicap accessibility, as well as a new outdoor pavilion/common area between the proposed addition and the existing Medical Billing modular. 
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
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
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




NEW SOUTH ELEVATION
