The Karuk Tribe requests proposals for the following Scope of Work required for a future expansion strategic site plan. The site plan will be used to determine available space, property/facility/parking layout, bidding and construction of a future Medical complex located at 64105 Hillside Rd. Happy Camp, Ca 96039. The design of the future expansion plan will include the addition of an adjoining dental clinic to the currently planned Medical clinic, a medical administration office building, a medical billing office building, emergency generator(s), a parking lot and should consider the existing 4,600 square foot Family Services Center. 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
