The Karuk Tribe requests Statement of Qualifications for the following Scope of Work required to provide Archaeological knowledge, skills and ability to conduct the following services.

Scope of Services to be Provided:

- 1. Identify at-risk historic properties of religious and cultural significance to the Karuk Tribe within various Federal undertakings and, if warranted, assess the potential effects of the undertaking on such properties and, if needed, provide standard resource protection measures to prevent adverse effects.
- 2. Review and provide written comments to survey reports for undertakings.
- 3. If a survey report makes a finding of adverse effects to at-risk historic properties of religious and cultural significance to the Karuk Tribe, a Historic Properties Treatment Plan will be included in the report.
- 4. Provide oversight of Karuk cultural monitors during implementation of project activities where at-risk historic properties of religious and cultural significance to the Karuk Tribe within undertakings are present, following stipulations in the cultural monitoring plan.
