Natural Resources Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

- Student must be an enrolled Karuk Tribal member or enrolled Karuk Tribal Descendent.
- Student must be pursuing an Associate of Arts (AA), Associate of Science (AS), Bachelor of Arts (BA), or Bachelor of Science (BS) degree in Natural Resources
- ➢ No funding is available for Graduate Students.
- Students must be enrolled full-time which is defined as 12 units or more.
- Students must maintain a 2.0 Grade Point Average (GPA) every grading term.
- Students must remain in good standing with the educational institution they attend.
- Students are not eligible for this scholarship from the Education Department of the Karuk Tribe if they are in default with the Tribe for any loan.
- Scholarship payments are sent directly to the school
