The Karuk Tribe Housing Authority (KTHA) is currently accepting applications for consideration from interested Tribal Members residing in the Yreka area to serve on the Board of Commissioners.

There is currently one (1) seat available for the remainder of a term expiring July 30, 2016. The seat shall represent the <u>Yreka</u> area.

The mission of the Karuk Tribe Housing Authority is to maintain current assets and remedy unsafe and unsanitary housing conditions that are injurious to the public health, safety and morals, and alleviate the acute shortage of decent, safe and sanitary dwellings for persons of low-income, and to promote and sustain the culture, education, language, health, welfare, self-sufficiency, and economic independence of its residents.

The Board meets at least twice each month on Mondays. The meeting locations rotate between Yreka, Happy Camp, and Orleans. Board Members are expected to travel as necessary to attend meetings, trainings, and conferences. Board Members are compensated with \$150 stipends for their time at regular Board of Commissioner Meetings; \$75 for special meetings four (4) hours or less; \$150 for special meetings over four (4) hours; \$50 per day when travelling for official KTHA related business; and \$75 for participating in interviews. Mileage is paid if required.
