The Karuk Tribe requests proposals for the following Scope of Work that is required for the submission of an application for the installation six (6) additional radio repeater units and required equipment to the existing radio repeater system that sits on Orleans Mountain located on the Six Rivers National Forest in Humboldt County. The application process will require coordination with The Klamath (KNF) and Six Rivers (SRF) National Forest, California Highway Patrol (CHP), California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection, Siskiyou Ranger Unit (SKU) and the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). The Six Rivers and Klamath National Forest are requiring that a separate application be submitted to each forest.

The project will consist of one (1) Daniels Z40509 UHF, 30 Watt Link Radio for existing Orleans Mountain repeater. Six (6) Daniels Z40508 VHF, 30 Watt, P25 Repeaters, with UHF 30 Watt Link Radios, set up on Ukonom Mountain (SRF), Slater Butte (KNF or CHP), Lake Mountain (KNF), Collins Baldy (KNF), Paradise Craggy (SKU) and Gunsight (CHP). Six (6) VHF, Antenna Systems Complete, includes (1) Celwave 1121, 3db gain antenna, (1) DB230 Yagi antenna, ½ inch Andrews Heliax, Solder/Clamp Connectors, jumpers and lightning protection. Seven (7) UHF, Antenna Systems Complete, includes (1) Yagi antenna, 1/2 inch Andrews Heliax, Solder/Clamp Connectors, jumpers and lightning protection. This system may include the installation of additional solar panels and/or batteries and/or indoor/outdoor locking storage cabinets.

This system should have the ability to communicate with a central hub to simulcast to all the repeaters at one time or the ability to link up two repeaters to communicate from one area to the other through a tone selection procedure. For example the system shall have the ability to talk from Independence Creek area (Happy Camp) off the Slater Butte Repeater to Yreka Child and Family Services office on the Gunsight Repeater with the selection of an appropriate tone.

Task One

The completion of technical data sheet, FS 2700-10, for each site detailing the equipment, frequency, power source and planned installation information shall be prepared and submitted to the Klamath and Six Rivers Nation Forest for the appropriate sites. Any required coordination with the FCC shall be the responsibility of the contractor.

Task Two

The completion of technical data sheet, DT-311-CHP, for each site detailing the equipment, frequency, power source and planned installation information shall be prepared and submitted to the California Highway Patrol for appropriate sites. Any required coordination with the FCC shall be the responsibility of the contractor

Task Three

The completion of technical data sheet, DT-312-CDF, for each site detailing the equipment, frequency, power source and planned installation information shall be prepared and submitted to California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection for appropriate sites Any required coordination with the FCC shall be the responsibility of the contractor

Responses to this Request for Proposals should include the following:

- 1) A statement of qualifications, including relevant project history.
- 2) A proposed approach and rational for completion of the contract tasks described above, including descriptions of similar work previously completed and the results/benefits achieved.
- 3) A lump sum price, with attached hourly and travel expense rate sheet [this can be modified to include specific details you need based on the project/work].
- 4) Names and telephone numbers of three client references.
