- 3. Shall pickup interoffice mail from Happy Camp Housing Authority and deliver to Yreka Housing.
- 4. Shall pickup and deliver interoffice mail to Yreka Medical Clinic Receptionist, TANF, Head start, Amkuuf Smoke Shop, Child & Family Services, and Rain Rock Casino as needed Monday through Friday. Happy Camp mail is delivered to the Administration Receptionist.
